Why does Liselinde collect data?

On the Liselinde website, I write about my experiences as a starting designer. Next to that, the website also contains a portfolio. I want to take my visitors along with me and therefore I find it important that the stories I write and the subjects I place are interesting to the reader. In order to be able to adjust the content as well as possible to the interests of the reader, I collect analytical data about the visits to my site.

I like to hear from my readers what they think about the posts. That is why I'm giving readers the possibility to leave comments, subscribe to my blog or contact me through the contact form on the website or through email. I will store the personal data provided with these actions only to contact the person involved.

Similarly for social media, where I take the reader along in my life and share my work: I store the account data only for contacting the person involved.

Finally, where it is required by law, I collect personal contact information, since this data is necessary for e.g. taxes. This data is stored up to a maximum of 7 years. (as required by law)

Which data is collected?

To shed some light on the surfing behaviour of my readers, I keep track of how many people visit my site and how many times individual posts are visited. I also keep track of the keywords used to find my website through search engines in order to be more visible there. For analysing the functioning of my website, no IP-addresses or personal information is collected. This data is fully anonymous.

When placing a comment on a post, filling out the contact form or sending me an email, the used name and email address will be recorded. For the comment and contact forms, the IP address is also recorded. If a contact requests it, I will also store the phone number.

On social media, I store account information from individuals and companies that I follow, that follow me, or that have contacted me in the past.

None of the personal information made available to me will be made publicly available or supplied to third parties.

How is analytical data collected?

What are cookies?

Cookies are small files that are sent by a website and stored on your computer by your web browser. Amongst other things, cookies store your preferred settings for the website and make sure that the website works correctly for you.

Different types of cookies

The website uses three different types of cookies:

1. First party cookies
These cookies ensure the correct working of the website. These cookies fall outside the cookie law.
2. Analytical cookies
These cookies give insight into the visitors' usage of the website. Your privacy is not affected by these cookies, because the data collected is fully anonymous. Because of this, these cookies too fall outside the cookie law.
3. Third-party (tracking) cookies
These cookies track the surfing behaviour of visitors within the website and outside the website. The social media buttons distribute tracking cookies, not for use by me, but rather for the social media companies. The tracking cookies are the reason you have to give permission as a user of the website; you have to consent to the placement of these tracking cookies on your computer; see the cookie bar at the bottom of the website.

Jetpack

To keep track of how people behave while visiting my website, I use Jetpack. Read the cookie policy of Jetpack [here](#). Jetpack uses analytical cookies.

Social media buttons

To share my posts with others easily, I placed a number of social media buttons on my website. These services employ tracking cookies. They are placed on your computer by the social media companies and I have no insight into the collected information. Underneath I have links to the privacy statements of the most commonly used social media providers, so you can read what they do with the gathered information.

Disable or delete cookies?

You can disable cookies in the settings of your internet browser. Adjust your settings such that your browser no longer stores cookies. You can also remove all or some of the previously stored cookies from your harddisk through the settings menu of your browser.

How does Liselinde get personal information?

For collecting and processing personal information, I use:

- Hosting of the website
- Wordpress
- Mail servers

The personal information will be shared with the parties mentioned above. I have data processing agreement with each of these parties, stating that they will not supply personal data to third parties.

How is personal information protected?

Liselinde takes the protection of your personal information seriously and has taken the necessary precautions to protect against unlawful access, loss or other forms of unauthorized processing of personal data. Specifically:

- I use security software, such as a virus scanner and fire wall.
- The website is secured using TLS. (formerly SSL) Your data is transmitted through a secure data connection. You can verify this by the "https://" in the website's address and the green lock next to it.
- DNSSEC is an extra security measure (adding to DNS) for translation of the domain name to the coupled IP-address; it is provided with a digital signature. That way, redirecting from the site to a erroneous IP-address is prevented.
